

Minutes of the Ordinary Meeting of Rosedale Parish Council held on Thursday 8 July 2021 at 7.00pm

The Clerk extended her apologies to those meeting at Council for her late arrival – the meeting started at 7:30pm

07788 The Council **received** apologies for absence from Cllrs H Brown, R Dent and C Binns

07789 There were no Declarations of Interest in items on the agenda

07790 The Council **agreed** that the Clerk will remain the host and presenter of the meeting for virtual attendees

07791 No members of the public were present

07792 The Council **received** the minutes of the meeting 10 June 2021

07793 Planning (and related items)

- a) The Council **noted** that no material planning applications have been found by the Clerk from NYCC, NYMNPA and Ryedale District Council since the previous meeting – this excludes AGRP

- b) The Council noted decisions regarding applications previously received and processed at the time of publication

07794 Financial Information

- a) The Council **received** financial statements in respect of funds held and money movement since the start of the financial year
- b) The Council **noted** and **agreed** cheques and instructions to the bank for processing.

07795 Villages

- a) The Council **received** an update regarding the car park noting that the draft contract is in development

Councillors wish to consider whether an amendment to plans will be required to consider a revised access route to the car park for health and safety issues

- b) The Council **received** information regarding grant and parish application options including Woodland Trust Trees for the Jubilee.

The Council requested that the Clerk applied for Trees for the Jubilee to be used for commemoration and for landscaping of the Car Park in development. A request for the Birds and Butterfly option was made as preference with delivery of the trees if we are successful to Cllrs L & T Dale

- c) The Council **received** an update regarding the toilets noting that there are still repairs which have been reported to RDC that are in the progress of work order preparation. The Clerk reported that interviews have taken place with the formal outcome to be reported when known

- d) The Council **received** an update regarding the monitoring of the Rosedale East noticeboard noting that currently there appears to be no further consideration needed for locking the community board

- e) The Council **thanked** Cllr R Dent for repairs to bridge handrails accessing the campsite

- f) The Council **received** information regarding parking at the bridge narrowing point in Rosedale Abbey noting that suggestion for seasonal road markings restricting parking to ensure the passage of larger business vehicles and emergency transport.

The Council considered this and have asked that a request be forwarded to NYCC for consideration after consulting with Cllrs Brown, Hebron and representatives of the central business community

- g) The Council **considered** action to be taken relating to the installation of a street lamp outside the Reading Room.

Previous discussions have considered wired control but given the relevance of night skies and green technology the Council received and example of solar lighting.

The Clerk was asked to provide further options for consideration and obtain costing information

- h) The Council considered possible fundraising ideas and also “path” for entering Britain in Bloom next year – include possible areas requiring repair to assist in the visual benefit allowing time for land disturbance to be “blended” – the Caretaker has identified these areas and local land owners have been approached to discuss this

- i) The Council **received** an update regarding Thorgill Bridge noting that NYCC have issued a works order for repairs

07796 Caretaker

The Council received information regarding caretaking activity and requests were made to ensure that visibility splays were kept "trim" for the safety of road users and members of the public. It has been reported that the "Dorothy (Solo Club)" seat near Primrose Villas is now in a state which is dangerous. The Caretaker has been asked to remove it and the Clerk to contact the owners of the bench to see if they would like to replace the bench. A suggestion to retain the rear of the seat which is carved be made.

07797 The Council noted that the Council will start formal co-option advertising once full relaxation of lockdown is confirmed (19 July 2021)

07798 The Council received information from Cllr E Dent regarding meetings attended and dates of future meetings.

07799 The Council received information from the Clerk noting an increase in applications for commemorative benches and tress. There has also been an increase in third party applications for inclusion in the website.

Council have requested that the Clerk presents an updated website policy including guidance regarding advertising for consideration.

Cllr Storey asked if it was possible for a call out for additional first responders be made. Cllr Storey to liaise with the Clerk to create a news item for this.

07800 Questions to and information from the Chairman – none received other than those covered elsewhere in the meeting

07801 The Council received possible dates for the delayed electorate meeting from Mr France. The Clerk was asked to request dates further into the autumn period

07802 The Council noted the date of the next meeting as 12 August 2021 subject to ongoing changes in restrictions
